Besides rewarding the top units for their effort and creativity, one of the reasons we are posting this scoresheet is to make all units aware of the criteria used by Peterloon to assess quality campsites.

Be advised, however, that campsite judging criteria may change from one encampment to the next based on different encampment criteria. Unit leaders should check with encampment organizers in advance to determine the criteria.

To break the tie at the top four troop sites for Peterloon and award winning positions, the judges made their final determinations based on overall impact, neatness, and esthetics. All four placing units should feel justly proud of their accomplishments, but special congratulations go to Troop 941.
