In this position, he worked closely with his majesty King Karl 16<sup>th</sup> Gustav of Sweden, the Patron and Honorary President of the World Scout Foundation. This work took Tom to countries all over the world and brought him into working relationships with National Scout Associations across the globe. As a result of this experience, he was awarded the Baden-Powell World Fellowship and a special commendation from the World Scout Movement. In the BSA, Tom has served as Scout Executive/Chief Executive Officer for councils in Albany, GA; Raleigh, NC and Oklahoma City, OK.

Mr. Dugger is active in Cub Scouts with son, Joseph Paul and Boy Scouts with son, William Thomas. Mr. Dugger and his wife, Marilyn, enjoy the Cultural Arts and Outdoor Activities.
